The following Claremore Park and Recreation facilities are currently open with applicable social distancing restrictions.

- Dog Park, limited to 10 people per social distancing guidelines.
- The Claremore Recreation Center: weight room, tennis courts, walking track, spin and aerobic classes are open. Social distancing guidelines are being followed and equipment is either spaced 6-feet apart, or every other machine has been taken out of service. Masks are encouraged and additional disinfectant is provided for guests to keep machines wiped down. The gymnasium will be open for shooting only; no games, leagues or practices will be permitted. The pool remains closed for repairs, and the racquetball court and childcare operations will remain closed until Phase 3.
- Community Center with limited occupancy requirements.
- Claremore Lake Jackpot. Social distancing guidelines are being followed, especially during registration and weigh-in.

Phase 2 and Phase 3 activities are subject to the Governor's notification to proceed. Additional planned Park and Recreation re-openings will include:

- In Phase 2, organized sports at City facilities (baseball, soccer, softball) will be allowed to start practicing per social distancing guidelines.
- In Phase 3, games for organized sports can resume, and playgrounds, splash pads and the indoor fishing dock can reopen.
