



ORDINANCE NO. 2021 - 2

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 96.06
OF CHAPTER 96, TITLE IX OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE CITY
OF CLAREMORE, OKLAHOMA, REGARDING FACE COVERINGS AND
SOCIAL DISTANCING DURING COVID-19 PANDEMIC CIVIL EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the City of Claremore, pursuant to the powers delegated to it by the Oklahoma Constitution, Oklahoma Statutes, and as a Charter City, has the authority to repeal Section 96.06 of Chapter 96, Title IX of the City Ordinances regarding face coverings and social distancing during Covid-19 pandemic civil emergency; and

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Claremore, Oklahoma, that:

Section 1. Repealer. That Section 96.06 of Chapter 96, Title IX of the Ordinances of the City of Claremore, Oklahoma be repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. Severability Clause. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason found to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance or any part thereof.

Section 3: Publication. The City Clerk is hereby ordered and directed to cause this Ordinance to be published as required by law.

Section 4: Emergency Clause. An emergency is hereby declared to exist where by it is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Claremore, Oklahoma, that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately from and after its passage, approval and adoption.

PASSED AND APPROVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Claremore, Oklahoma, this 5th day of April, 2021, by vote on Sections Nos. 1 through 3 and then by separate vote on Section No. 4 (the Emergency Clause).
